An attempt at formulating an imperfect tense verb (bullet-point one) and a conditional-tense verb (bullet-point five) must be made.

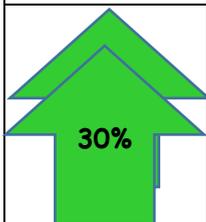
Speaking
