





My tenses are not usually accurate.</p> <p><b>Reading</b> I can understand the main points and opinions of shorter texts. I can translate 50 words from French into English but the meaning is sometimes unclear.</p> <p><b>Writing</b> I can translate simple phrases from English into Spanish but there may be some errors.
