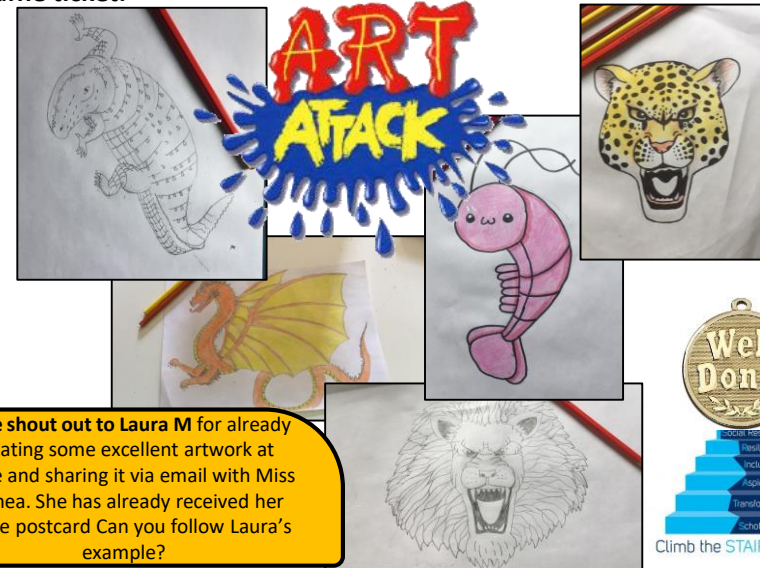
1. Each morning before 9am you need to be checking in with your House Coach by clicking on your House Group on the school website. This is really important so that we know you are well and safe. The registration links are here:

School Work on Microsoft Teams:

Remember this is what you should be doing every day

Time	
8.30 – 9am	Complete registration with your house coach through the OASB website here: https://www.oasisacademysouthbank.org/curriculum/student-learning
9am	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log in to Microsoft Teams (you will be shown how to do this!) 2. Click on your class group 3. Download the assignment set for you by your teacher. This will go “live” at 9am 
9am – 4pm	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete the four assignments for your four lessons in the day 2. Your teacher will leave clear instructions and a pre-recorded video to help you with the assignment 3. You can complete the assignment online or on paper 4. At your normal lesson time your teacher will be “live” online for you to ask any questions you might have about the assignment
Before 4pm	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log in to Microsoft Teams 2. “Hand in” your assignment for your four lessons 3. Your teacher will check that you have completed it at 4pm and your house coach will phone home once a week if you have not completed these
After 4pm	Your teacher might set you homework (e.g. Hegarty) like normal and you must complete this before the due date

Tips: follow the same timetable that you have at school and include breaks. Keep asking your teachers questions online!
